Hawkwood Business Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, January 14, 2025

The Polling of Confidence regarding our baronage transition is ongoing through February 8th. It's not strictly a vote; it's more of an opportunity to let the Kingdom know how we feel. The polling is conducted on the Kingdom of Atlantia polling site, https://polling.atlantia.sca.org/.

Hawkwood was extremely well-represented at the finals of the Kingdom-wide Titan Tournament finals at Nottinghill Coill Baronial Birthday. Aleksandre, Arias, Ellie, Greylond, and Tiberius all competed.

Master Tiberius won the Rapier Titan Tournament and currently holds a large pointy trident to that effect.

Arias will be sprucing up the portable list field that the Canton of Stormwall has, with a cost of \$270 for new painted stakes and a thousand feet of rope. A lifespan of 10 years is anticipated. It can be stored in Arias's garage indefinitely.

Our current Chatelain is stepping down; we will need a new one. Please contact the Seneschal.

Events to be attended by the Baroness include Nottinghill Coill Baronial Birthday and Ice Castles [both now past].

Stormwall report: We won't be attending Greening Up The Mountains this year, and plan to find a replacement event. Whispers of War is being planned for June 6-8. The last two Stormwall fighter practices have also been A&S meetups; it's been going well.

Baronial storage is a concern, since the Baron is moving away. We should consider buying a trailer. We must find a temporary location for the Gold Key.

Dinner Night Out is coming up March 22nd. We should consider a Swannanoa or Old Fort location.

Tuesday, November 12, 2024

Seneschal report: The Kingdom needs you to put in bids for Kingdom events. Of the awards given at War of the Wings, the Seneschal wants to bring special attention to the Meridien awards given to Aleksandre and Signy.

The incoming Exchequer is taking the necessary classes.

A&S Report: Signy's term as royal bard is coming to an end at the Royal Bardic competition, in the northern reaches of the Kingdom. A&S for many people has been on hold due to the overall emergency. Ilse's embroidery tarot cards are of merit. A&S get-togethers in the park along with fighter practices are good, maybe once a month.

Knight's Marshal report: Many awards at War of the Wings, including Ellie's Sea Dragon, and Shark's Teeth for several Hawkwood fighters, including Talor and Irving.

The Baron plans to attend Yule-Toy.

The Baroness plans to attend the Sylva Christmas Parade. Hawkwood should attend Nottinghill Coill Baronial Birthday to support our many Titan Tournament competitors. There is a silverware pouch making event in Sylva. [These events are now past].

Our event Memento Mori was canceled due to the storm, so there's no event wrap-up to go.

(There was not an October business meeting due to Hurricane Helene.)

Tuesday, September 10, 2024

The Kingdom [was then] seeking a new steward for the painted shields used at Crown Tourney; contact Kingdom Seneschal.

At Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday, there was a serious accident with the propane showers; official information on the matter is available on the Atlantia announcements Facebook group.

The Exchequer reports a bank balance of \$6,398.92.

The Herald reports that the names and devices of Aleksandr Tomasovic and Johannes Godfelawe have passed, as well as the name of Jasper of Hawkwood.

Knight's Marshal reports good turnout at Sacred Stone Baronial birthday, and a focus on weapons maintenance at recent practices. Aleksandr and Arias plan to make a formal plan to improve the portable list field.

The Baron is proud of our performance at Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday: at this point we had three fighters qualified for the Titan tournament.

Memento Mori planning is largely complete.

War of the Wings camp and party planning is underway.

Congratulations to the Hawkwood rapier fighters, who won two unit awards at Pennsic.

His Excellency will be in charge of the agenda.
